
SET UP ON YOUR SMARTPHONE




POWER ON THE HEARPHONES™

When powered on for the first time, the battery light glows and the *Bluetooth* light blinks blue.



WEAR THE HEARPHONES™

Note: To learn more about how to find the right size StayHear+ tip, see page 5.



- B. Follow the app instructions to connect your Hearphones™.


HEARPHONES™ COMPONENTS



PROPER STAYHEAR+ TIP FIT

The headphones come with medium sized StayHear+ tips attached to the earbuds and small and large tips included in the box. If the medium eartip feels too loose, try the large eartip. If the eartip feels too tight, try the small eartip.


Note: All ears are different. It's even possible that your ears are different sizes, so you'll want to experiment until you find the size that's just right.




CHANGE THE STAYHEAR+ TIP (IF NEEDED)

A. Hold the earbud with one hand, and with the other, gently peel the eartip base off of the earbud.

Note: To prevent tearing, do NOT pull on the eartip wing.




B. Slide the earbud nozzle into the opening of the new eartip, then snap it into place.

CONTROL WORLD VOLUME AND DIRECTIVITY




CHANGE WORLD VOLUME

FUNCTION	WHAT TO DO
Increase World Volume (amplify environmental sounds)	Press ▲.
Decrease World Volume (reduce environmental sounds)	Press ▼.

NOTE: You can also change World Volume with the Bose Hear app.

CHANGE DIRECTIVITY


Press ▲ and ▼ simultaneously until you hear the tone for your preferred mode.



DIRECTIVITY MODE	DESCRIPTION
Everywhere (low tone)	Hear sounds from all directions.
Front (medium tone)	Concentrate on a conversation with more than one person and reduce noise from behind.
Focused (high tone)	Focus on a conversation with someone in a noisy environment.


