

Important Safety Instructions Before You Begin...

To avoid potential problems and hazards, please observe the following:

- Read instructions. Read all of these safety and operating instructions before you use your RoomMate® computer monitor
- Retain instructions. Retain these safety and operating instructions for future reference.
- Heed warnings. Adhere to all warnings on the RoomMate computer monitor and in these operating instructions.
- Follow instructions. Follow all operating and use instructions as outlined in this guide.
- Water and moisture. Never use your RoomMate computer monitor near water—for example, near a bathtub, sink, laundry tub, in a wet basement, near a swimming pool, etc.
- 6. Mounting. Use only Bose® MMA-4 Mounting Arms, WB-11 Wall Brackets, or WC-7 Wall/Ceiling Brackets to mount your RoomMate computer monitor. Consult the instructions supplied with the mounting arms or brackets and mount your RoomMate computer monitor only in the manner recommended by Bose.
- 7. Ventilation. Be sure to provide adequate ventilation for the LEFT (POWERED) speaker that has the AC (mains) line cord and audio input cables going into it. For example, the LEFT (POWERED) speaker should not be placed in a built-in bookcase or cabinet that may impede the flow of air around the system.

- 8. Heat. Avoid placing the system near direct heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other appliances (including amplifiers) that produce heat. Avoid placing the system in direct sunlight.
- Power sources. The RoomMate®
 computer monitor is available in
 120V~ and 220V~ models. Be
 sure your system is compatible
 with your AC voltage.
- 10. Power cord protection. Route the power supply (mains) cord so that it will not be walked on, cut, or pinched by items placed upon or against it. Pay particular attention to the cord at the plug and at the point where it connects with the RoomMate computer monitor.
- 11. Non-use periods. If the Room-Mate® computer monitor is not going to be used for any length of time, unplug it from the wall outlet. Always unplug the unit by grasping the plug itself. Never pull the plug out by the cord.
- 12. Object and liquid entry. Take care that objects do not fall and liquids do not spill into the enclosure of the RoomMate computer monitor through the openings.
- 13. Cleaning/care and maintenance. The RoomMate computer monitor requires very little maintenance. Occasional cleaning should be done with a damp cloth WHILE THE SYSTEM IS UNPLUGGED. Never use any chemicals to clean your system, and never allow any liquids to enter the unit's openings.
- 14. Use with other systems. Do not connect either the POWERED (left) speaker or the ACCESSORY (right) speaker to any other manufacturer's system.

- 15. Servicing. Never attempt to service the RoomMate computer monitor yourself. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- 16. Damage requiring service. Have your RoomMate computer monitor serviced by qualified service personnel when any of the following things occur:
 - The power supply cord or plug has been damaged.
 - b. Objects have fallen onto or liquid has spilled into the enclosure.
 - The RoomMate computer monitor has been exposed to rain.
 - d. The system does not appear to operate normally or shows a marked change in performance.
 - The RoomMate computer monitor has been dropped or the enclosure damaged.

ATTENTION

This unit is equipped with a polarized alternating current line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other). This plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If the plug should still fail to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized plug.

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Bose® RoomMate® computer monitor. These versatile speakers are designed to provide high fidelity stereo sound from any computer system software package featuring sound. The RoomMate computer monitor is also compatible with all musical keyboards, CD players (home decks and portable models) and VCR's. The speakers are magnetically shielded so that you may place the system near your computer screen.

Because the RoomMate computer monitor is so unique, please take the time to read and follow the instructions in this owner's guide. They will help you get the most enjoyment from your new system.

1. How to Use Your RoomMate® Computer Monitor

Unpacking

Open the carton and carefully remove the foam packing cradles. Next, remove the packing cradles from each speaker. Save all packing materials, this owner's guide, and the two supplied adapters for possible future use.

The two adapters are supplied for connecting your RoomMate computer monitor to a variety of monophonic and stereo sound sources. The mono jack adapter can be identified by the single black band on the tip of the adapter plug. The stereo jack adapter can be identified by the two black bands on the tip of the adapter. Other types of adapters are available at most electronic supply stores which may allow you to connect your RoomMate computer monitor to an even wider variety of devices. See your dealer for additional information.

Hooking Up

Before you plug the RoomMate computer monitor into the wall outlet, make sure that all the following connections have been made properly and that the volume control is turned all the way down.

a. Carefully identify the two separate speakers. The LEFT (POWERED) speaker has the AC (mains) cord, input connectors, and speaker terminals located on the back. The RIGHT (ACCESSORY) speaker has speaker terminals.



 Use the enclosed two-conductor speaker wire to connect the terminals on the LEFT speaker with those on the RIGHT speaker (Fig. 1). The conductor with the RED stripe should be connected to the RED terminal on the back of each speaker. The remaining all-BLACK conductor should be connected to the BLACK terminal on each speaker. To make the connection at each terminal, simply press the button located at the base of the terminal. This will expose a small opening in the terminal, into which the bare end of the wire should be inserted.



 Connect the speakers to the sound source according to the appropriate instructions below.

Apple® IIGS® or Macintosh® Plus and SE Computers (Fig. 2)

The Apple IIGS and Macintosh computers utilize a mono mini headphone jack for audio output. For proper performance, use the supplied mono jack adapter. This adapter can be identified by the single black band on the tip of the plug. Insert the phono plugs from the powered speaker into the adapter and insert the adapter into the headphone jack of the computer.

Macintosh II Computers (Fig. 2)

The Macintosh II utilizes a stereo mini headphone jack for audio output. For proper performance, use the supplied stereo jack adapter. This adapter can be identified by the two black bands on the tip of the plug. Insert the phono plugs from the powered speaker into the adapter and insert the adapter into the headphone jack of the computer.

Apple CD ROM Drive (Fig. 3)

Insert the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into the AUDIO output jacks on the back of the Apple CD ROM drive. The RED plug is RIGHT and the BLACK plug is LEFT.

If preferred, you can hook up the RoomMate® computer monitor into the headphone jack on the front of the Apple CD ROM drive by inserting the phono plugs into the supplied adapter and plugging the adapter into the headphone jack.

Musical Keyboards (Fig. 3)

The RoomMate computer monitor may be used with any musical key-board. Insert the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into the left and right phono outputs on the back of the keyboard. The RED plug is RIGHT and the BLACK plug is LEFT. If the keyboard has only one large

headphone output jack, connect the



phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into a 1/4-inch headphone jack adapter and then hook up to the keyboard. This adapter is not supplied, but is available at most stereo shops.

Compact Disc Players (Fig. 3)

The RoomMate computer monitor may be used with both home and portable compact disc players. Insert the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into the left and right audio outputs of the compact disc player. The RED plug is RIGHT (R) and the BLACK plug is LEFT (L). If the compact disc player has only one headphone output jack, connect the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into an appropriate stereo headphone jack adapter and then hook up to the compact disc player.

VCR's and Televisions (Fig. 3)

Insert the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into the left and right audio outputs of the VCR or television. The RED plug is RIGHT (R) and the BLACK plug is LEFT (L). If the television has only one headphone audio output jack, insert the phono plugs from the POWERED speaker into an appropriate headphone jack adapter and then hook up to the television.

d. Plug the POWERED speaker's AC cord into the wall outlet. The system is now ready for use.

2. Operating the System

Properly connected, the Bose® Room-Mate® computer monitor is very easy to use. Simply follow the instructions below for volume and tone control and speaker placement.

Volume Control: This control lets you adjust the volume of the RoomMate computer monitor and is especially useful when the system is connected to components without volume controls (such as VCR's and disc players). To use, simply turn the control (located on the front of the POWERED speaker) to the RIGHT for increasing volume, and to the LEFT for decreasing volume. If the unit that the RoomMate computer monitor is connected to has a volume control, turn that unit's control up slightly. Then use the volume control on the RoomMate computer monitor to achieve desired volume levels.

NOTE: Make sure that the volume control on the RoomMate computer monitor is turned all the way down when you are not using it. If the system is not going to be used for any length of time, unplug it from the wall outlet.

Adjusting Tone: The RoomMate computer monitor incorporates an optimized, preset equalizer for proper bass and treble balance. This tone setting cannot be adjusted. However, any tone controls on the source unit (such as the tone control on a TV) can be used when the source unit is playing through the RoomMate computer monitor.

Placing the Speakers: Generally, placement close to the monitor screen provides the most realistic sound image. Since the RoomMate computer monitor is magnetically shielded, it can be placed directly next to a screen without causing image interference. The speakers may be placed vertically, if preferred. (You can rotate the Bose logo in its center position; gently remove the grille, release the logo's stickpin, and refasten it through one of the two plastic tabs with a hole.) If longer distances are required between the speakers, simply replace the speaker wire (supplied) with a suitable length of 18-gauge (.75 mm) speaker wire.

3. In Case of Difficulty

Although actual servicing should be referred to qualified personnel, many problems that might occur are more likely to be the result of improper hookup rather than any real defect. If you have any of the following problems, try the suggested solutions before returning your unit.

No sound with system plugged in. Source component (computer, keyboard, VCR, etc.) is not properly connected to the unit. Also, make sure that the source component itself is working properly (batteries are OK, tape has something on it, etc.). Check volume control if available on source component to make sure RoomMate® computer monitor is getting a signal.

System doesn't play.

Power cord may be either unplugged or improperly connected. Check cord and connections.

Only one speaker plays.

- The ACCESSORY SPEAKER (RIGHT) may be improperly connected. Check connection, wires, and terminals.
- The balance control on the source component might be turned all the way left or right. Check the control.
- The source component is only mono.
 Connect a "Y" connector adapter, and plug the RoomMate computer monitor back in.

Sound is too loud and/or is distorted.

The source component's volume may be too high. Turn the source volume down, and use the volume control on the RoomMate computer monitor.
